

## **Mentoring Session - December**

Our December mentoring sessions (Interims) are a well established popular yearly event for students who would like to spend quality time on creative work and to disappear from the Xmas. bustle. It is an opportunity to have an individual private mentoring session with Gail. She can assess your work, make suggestions and new learning opportunities for further study, or assist you in any ongoing work. Use the break to become energized, inspired or to spend a little more time on yourself. Bring the project that you are working on or would like to be working on and materials to work with. Share time and space with like minded students.

Gail will not be teaching any specific course but working individually with students on the project of their choosing. Tutorials are rotated so that every student is taken in turn. They may last in duration of 20 to 25 minutes each time. Depending on the no.of students enrolled, there will be two to three tutorials per day. Students can come into the studio space, set up their materials in either the wet or needlework studio and begin to work until their specified tutorial time. ### **Registering for a Session**

When students register for the session, they are placed in the registration order for tutorial times. The tutorial times are written on a white board at the front of the classroom to show the order that tutorials occur. The tutorials begin at 9:00a.m.each morning.

- Who would like to study in the library and work on any library project.
- Who would like tutorial or teaching time other than class projects.
- Who are not a student of the center but working independently
