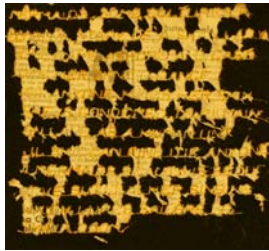


JUNE STEEGSTRA

DISCOVER DECORATIVE MACHINE STITCHING



Have you ever wondered what to do with all of those built in stitches on your sewing machine? This course will help you discover creative ways to use those stitches.

Decorative stitches will be sewn on a variety of specialized fabrics provided by tutor June Steegstra. Enriched textural surfaces are a result of the interaction between thread and fabric.

Each day's work will be themed to a primary color. Create hidden messages, make lace, and use hand embroidery to enhance bobbin work. Experiment with two threads through the needle, twin needle stitching, and couched ribbon and yarn. Other exciting techniques will be explored.

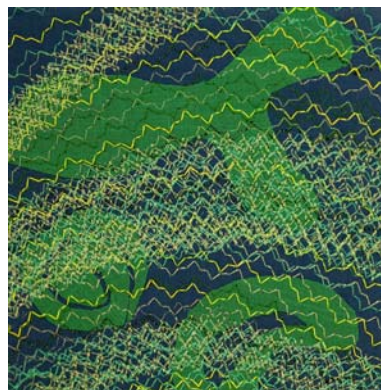
The Course

In these three days you will:

- ◆ Create a reference notebook with a variety of samples each day, a suitable future starting point for enhanced wearables, accessories or home décor.
- ◆ Create new fabric surfaces specifically designed for and with automatic stitches.
- ◆ Achieve sensational stitch effects in monochromatic, analogous and complementary colors schemes, as well as a tonal study.

Sewing Machines

Any machine you bring will need a minimum of 20 decorative stitches, or consider borrowing one of our Pfaff sewing machines in place of, or to supplement, your own.
