Institute. In 1995, after a thriving career teaching in the UK, she moved to America and founded *Gail Harker Center for Creative Arts* in La Conner, Washington. She is the author of five books: *Embroidery Skills: Machine Embroidery*, *Fairy Tale Quilts and Embroidery*, *Christmas Stitches*, *Creative Machine Embroidery*, and *Tassel Making* (self published in 2004 and available through the Center).

EXPERIMENTAL HAND STITCH



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Our courses are well known for their creative, contemporary approach to embroidery through basic design and color. This course serves as a basic introduction to the vast world of embroidery. Techniques and stitches will be imaginatively worked using the elements of design.

Using your own hand-painted fabric and threads, you will create a variety of small, embroidered samples. You will learn about the following:

- Dyeing fabric, threads and paper
- A wide variety of techniques and stitches: including couched threads, chain, button-hole, feather, fly stitch, knotted stitches, straight stitches as well as edging stitches
- Color study
- Needles and threads
- Stitching on fabric and paper
- Effective Presentation

A workbook of classroom notes with color photos will be provided to all students of the Gail Harker Creative Studies Center.

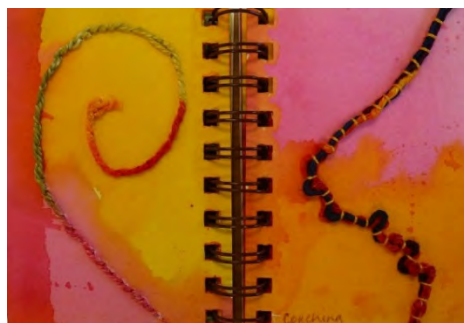
You will create a small book of stitches complete with binding. The variety of stitch samples will provide a source of inspiration from which to work for years to come.
